'Walk-in-Interview' for engagement of the following teachers purely on contractual basis against short term vacancies for Oak Grove School, (Northern Railway), Jharipani (Mussoorie) will be held on 16.09.2022 (Friday) at 10.00 A.M. for posts at serial no. (1) to (3) below and at 02.00 P.M. for posts at serial no. (4) to (5) below at Railway Officers' Rest House, Opposite Dehradun Railway Station.

(1) **ASSISTANT MISTRESS (PGT PHYSICS) (For Female Only)**

Qualifications :

A. Two years' Integrated Post Graduate M.Sc. Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in Physics. **OR** Master Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate in Physics / Electronics / Applied Physics / Nuclear Physics.

B. B.Ed. or equivalent degree from recognized university.

C. Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

Desirable:- Knowledge of computer applications.

(2) **ASSISTANT MASTER/MISTRESS (PGT HINDI)**

Qualifications :

A. Master Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate in Hindi or Sanskrit with Hindi as one of the subjects at Graduate level.

B. B.Ed. or equivalent degree from recognized university.

C. Proficiency in teaching in Hindi medium.

Desirable:- Knowledge of computer applications.

(3) **ASSISTANT MISTRESS (TGT HINDI) (For Female Only)**

Qualifications :

A. Graduation (in Hindi subject) and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) **OR** At least 50% marks either in Graduation (in Hindi subject) or in Post-Graduation (in Hindi subject) and B.Ed. **OR** Graduation (in Hindi subject) with at least 45% marks and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations issued from time to time in this regard. **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-years B.A./B.Sc.Ed or B.A.Ed./B.Sc.Ed. **OR**

Graduation (in Hindi subject) with at least 50% marks and 1-year B.Ed. (Special Education) **OR**

Post-Graduation (in Hindi subject) with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade and three-year integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed.

AND

B. Pass in the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET), to be conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

Provided that minimum percentage of marks in graduation shall not be applicable to those incumbents who had already taken admission to the Bachelor of Education or Bachelor of Elementary Education or equivalent course prior to the 09th December, 2013.

AND

C. Competence to teach through Hindi medium.

NOTE: Relaxation up to 5% in the educational qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/PH.

(4) **PHYSICAL TRAINING INSTRUCTOR (For Male Only)**

Qualifications :

A. Graduate with Bachelors in Physical Education (B. P. Ed) or its equivalent.

B. Competence to impart Physical Education through English medium.

(5) **ASSISTANT MISTRESS (JUNIOR SCHOOL) (PRT) (For Female Only)**

Qualifications :

A. Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2002. **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) **OR**

Graduation and two year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) **OR**

Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) **OR**

Post-Graduation with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade and three-year integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed.

AND

B. Pass in the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET), to be conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

C. Competence to teach in English medium.

NOTE: Relaxation up to 5% in the educational qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/PH.

Age Eligibility:

Between the age of 18 and 65 years for all categories.

NOTE :

(1) Candidates must bring with them application on a plain paper along with Passport size recent photograph and original and attested copies of their testimonials in support of age, qualification, caste and experience.

(2) Contractual teachers would be paid consolidated monthly remuneration of Rs.27,500/- for PGT, Rs.26,250/- for TGT/PTI & Rs.21,250/- for PRT. Teachers appointed on contractual basis will not be entitled for vacation pay and during summer/winter break. The payment will be regulated on pro rata basis only for the number of days worked.

(3) Competence to teach in English Medium School is essential for all the posts.

(4) Contractual teachers would not be entitled to any other facility like leave, medical, passes, PTOs, transportation etc.

(5) No TA/DA will be paid for the interview.

(6) There will be a gap of at least 07 days excluding the period of normal vacation as prescribed in school calendar between two successive contractual appointments for those candidates who have been engaged earlier as contractual teachers in Railway schools.

(7) Contract Teachers who enter into contract with the Railway will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract. Services rendered as contract will not have any right in respect of considering of their period in regular selection through Railway Recruitment Board and will not form part of the cadre of Railway Teachers.

(8) Engagement of contractual teachers on contract basis may be done for a maximum period of 200 working days and a minimum period of 7 working days or availability of regularly selected candidates, whichever is earlier and subject to any instruction issued from time to time.

(9) Such arrangements can be discontinued at any time without assigning any reason.

(10) The candidates should be ready and willing to stay in a boarding school environment.

Candidates appearing in the Walk-in-Interview should strictly follow the SOP on preventive measures to contain spread of COVID-19 like physical distancing, mandatory use of face covers/masks, installation & use of Aarogya Setu App etc. issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India.

Candidates who report between 10.00 A.M. to 12.30 P.M. for posts at sl. no. (1) to (3) above & between 02.00 P.M. to 04.30 P.M. for posts at sl. no. (4) to (5) above will only be interviewed.
